## **TECH TALK**

WHY are we changing our service to only offer HD channels?

**Shaw Broadcast Services:** "We are transitioning to [HD] because the legacy [SD] encoding equipment is reaching End of Support status. This means that within the next few years the [SD] encoding equipment used by Shaw Broadcast will no longer be able to be supported or repaired. Upgrading to current generation [HD] equipment allows our customers to continue to broadcast television signals for distribution."

Currently, we offer most channels in both SD and HD feeds. As SD comes off-air, you will obviously have fewer physical channels to watch, but you will still be receiving the same amount of programming. It just won't be duplicated.

Unfortunately, not every single channel is offered in HD at this time. We currently have lost the following channels:
